DIRECTIONS:

1. To find the location of each place use an **atlas**, your **textbook** (pp. A18-A21), **my website** wirkus.weebly.com [Homepage>Geography>Asia] as a reference), and or **Google Maps**.
2. Label all of the locations in **PENCIL**.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to write the text straight across & capitalize the first letter only.

3. Use a **LIGHT** blue pencil to completely shade in the bodies of water. Use a *darker* blue pencil to show the path of rivers.
4. Use colored pencils & *contrasting* colors (lighter colors next to darker ones), to **lightly & completely shade** in all the countries listed above.
5. Use a **fine-tip BLACK** ink pen to place a small **DOT •** in the approximate location of each city.
6. Finally, using a **fine-tip BLACK** ink pen, go over all the text where you previously used pencil.
